My travels and assorted news...

Attended the Conference of Major Superiors of Men (CMSM) in Atlanta last week. It was an excellent learning experience, thought provoking, and a networking opportunity. I was able to meet with **Dan O'Riordan, FMS**, provincial for the US Marists to discuss our collaboration with Cathedral El Paso's *El Otro Lado* program. **Stephen Olert** (DENA) and I caught up. He's working with the John Vianney House. I was very proud of our Lasallian representation. One of the keynotes was by the Springtide Director, Dr. Tricia Bruce. This nationally leading research firm in the spirituality of young people is a spin off from Saint Mary's Press. Christian Brothers Services (shout out to **Peter Tripp**) and Christian Brothers Investment Services were also represented. I was on a panel that discussed the past, present, and future impacts of the abuse cases on our congregations.
